#### **Important Information**

Please ensure all bags, lunchboxes, water bottles, clothes, hats, sun creams and toys are **NAMED** to avoid lost property. If one of your child's belongings is misplaced, please look in the lost property box, located on the lunch trolley at drop off and pick up time.

If your child is likely to be absent, please inform us by 9am (where possible) by phoning the preschool.

It is vital that you notify a member of staff when someone else will be collecting your child. Please ensure that the collecting adult has the password that was provided at registration. We will not be able to let your child leave the premises if the proper procedure is not adhered to. Please could we also remind parents/carers that anyone collecting children must be over 18 years of age.

The pre-school encourages healthy eating and therefore would ask that your child's lunch box does not contain fizzy drinks, chocolate, sweets etc. Due to allergies, the pre-school is a nut free zone so please ensure that there are **no products that contain nuts** in your child's lunchbox. Please ensure that grapes and cocktail sausages are cut in half to minimise the risk of choking.

Due to the unpredictability of our weather, please make sure that your child has appropriate outdoor clothing, such as; a jacket, wellington boots, hat and sun cream etc. Please note that if your child does not have appropriate outdoor clothing or protection they may be unable to access the outdoor areas.

#### **Achievements**

Last year was a very busy year for the team with regards to continuing their professional development.

Claire and Sam completed their 2 years of studying and successfully completed their level five foundation degree in Early Years Education. They also updated their safeguarding knowledge by completing their level four in Safeguarding training.

Nicky achieved her level four in Early Years Education, and completed Special Educational Needs training with Sam.

Claire, Sam and Sarah are qualified Lead Language Practitioners after attending training to increase their knowledge in supporting children with speech and language delay.

All the team participated in training over the year that enhanced their knowledge in first stage phonics and implementing the Early Years Foundation Stage. The team came into pre-school two days before the children this term to refresh their first aid and are now all qualified in level two pediatric first aid.
